AF CORSE LEADS ALL! Great Ferrari double victory at the 24-hours of Spa

Ferrari emphatically claimed the GT2 class win at Spa for the first time this weekend, sweeping aside any doubts about the new car's ability to last the gruelling 24-hours but placing five of the Ferrari 430 GT2 cars in the points at the end of the race.

AF Corse claimed a brilliant 1-2, with Mika Salo, Rui Aguas and Timo Scheider victorious in the #59 car. They were followed by the #58 car of Matteo Bobbi, Jaime Melo and Rui Aguas, with the leading Scuderia Ecosse Ferrari third, fighting their way back up the grid after an early off.

AF Corse and their drivers confirm themselves and remain once again to the top of the championship classification.
